SERMON RECAP

In hardship, it can be easy to feel like God isn't with us, but we can know with confidence that He is and is working for our good.

THE LEAD IN

- Share about a season of life where it felt like difficulties and trials kept piling up. Are there things you can see about that season now that you couldn't during it?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- The story of Joseph covers a lot of Genesis, read or skim chapters 37-41. How do you see God working His plans and purposes through the trials that Jacob encountered?
- Read 1 Peter 3:14-17 and Hebrews 12:7-11. What perspective should we take, as children of God, towards suffering or hardship that we face?

GOING DEEPER

- In Genesis 50, Joseph tells his brothers that what they intended for evil, God used for good. Are there areas in your life that you're trusting God's work in even though things feel bleak? What does that trust look like day to day?
- Tony encouraged us to share with others what we have learned, through hardship, about God – His plans, purposes, and practice. Share those lessons learned with each other in your group.

PRAYER

- Pray for each other in the hardships and trials you're facing. Ask God for daily trust, knowing that He is working all things for good.
