SERMON RECAP

Being strong and courageous needs more than optimism, more than belief, and more than action. We need God's promised presence with us wherever we go.

THE LEAD IN

- Share about a role or responsibility that when you entered it, it felt far too big and overwhelming for you. Why did you feel unqualified? What happened?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Joshua 1:1-9. As God blesses Joshua and transfers leadership to him after Moses' death, what promises does God extend to Joshua and what does He ask of him?
- Deuteronomy 31 is a parallel passage to Joshua 1 and tells of Joshua's commissioning. What similarities do you see between Deuteronomy 31:7-8 & 23 and the Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20?

GOING DEEPER

- You just read our commission as followers of Jesus Christ in Matthew 28. Tom called us to be action oriented and against apathy in our pursuit of the mission. What does it look like for you to be strong and courageous as you obediently do what God has called you to?
- Focus on the destination, heaven, is important, but so is the journey to get there. Are you living life with Jesus or life for Jesus? What's the difference? How do strength and courage play into your life with Him?

- God will be with you wherever you go! Ask Him for strength and courage as you live life with Him.
