

# LG DISCUSSION LIFEGROUPS GUIDE

Use these questions in your Life Group gatherings or for further discussion as a family.

## WHOM WILL YOU SERVE? | JUNE 7, 2026

### SERMON RECAP

*Joshua's final challenge to Israel is still the challenge before us: choose whom you will serve. There are only two options, and only through Jesus, our better witness, can we keep the covenant we make with God.*

### THE LEAD IN

- Who is someone in your life whose faith has been so consistent and settled that it has shaped the way you live? What made their example stick with you?

### GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Joshua 24:14-15. Joshua gives the people a clear choice: serve the Lord or serve other gods. What does Joshua's declaration, "as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord," reveal about the kind of influence a person can have on those in their sphere?
- Read Joshua 24:19-20. Joshua pushes back on the people's enthusiastic commitment by saying they are not able to serve the Lord. What is he getting at, and why is this warning important rather than discouraging?

### GOING DEEPER

- Tom pointed out that the stone Joshua set up was a witness against the people, not for them, and that within one generation Israel had abandoned the Lord entirely. Where in your own life are you tempted to assume your commitment to God rather than actively choosing it?
- Tom described Jesus as our "better witness," one who is for us rather than against us. How does keeping your eyes on Christ as the faithful witness change the way you approach your failures and your ongoing call to serve him?

### PRAYER

- Ask God to reveal any area where you have been serving a lesser god without naming it as such. Pray for one person in your Oikos by name, that they would encounter the God who is worth serving above all others.
