## MAKING DISCIPLES OF ALL NATIONS | JULY 19, 2026

### CONTEXT

*LEFC hosted a guest speaker this week. In lieu of a discussion around the sermon, this week's guide focuses on our call to being on mission and making disciples of all nations.*

### THE LEAD IN

- Have you ever befriended someone of a different cultural or religious background? How were their background and beliefs different than yours? What surprised you about them?

### GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Colossians 4:2-6. What are the things Paul asks the church to pray for him and for themselves? What is his exhortation to how to interact with those who aren't Christ followers?
- In 1 Peter 3:15-16, we see a similar encouragement of how to respond to those who don't know Christ. What similarities do you see to the Colossians 4 passage? Why are the message, tone, and posture of our interactions important?

### GOING DEEPER

- How comfortable are you sharing your faith with others? What fears hold you back the most? How do the passages we studied above encourage you?
- Consider your Oikos. What is a practical step or conversation that you could seek to take this week with someone in your Oikos who doesn't profess faith in Christ? Share with your group so they can pray and hold you accountable!

### PRAYER

- Pray that God would open wide doors for the gospel, both in your Oikos and around the world! Pray for courage and boldness that you would take advantage of opportunities placed before you.
