## LITTLE FAITH | JULY 26, 2026

### SERMON RECAP

*God causes our faith to grow as we obey, listen, trust, yield, and worship.*

### THE LEAD IN

- In what situations in life do you feel like your faith is small? How so?

### GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Matthew 14:22-33. Jesus makes the disciples go into the boat and go ahead of Him, and they spend a night rowing into the wind and waves. Why did Jesus send them onto the lake? What does Peter's request of Jesus in verse 28 tell us about his growing faith?
- Consider who Colossians 1:15-17 says Jesus is. How do we see Jesus like this in the passage in Matthew 14? How can our faith be encouraged knowing that this is who Jesus is?

### GOING DEEPER

- What are the distractions, fears, hidden sin, circumstances, and hurts you're carrying that are like the waves Peter encountered - things that cause you to take your eyes off Christ? What holds you back from crying out "Lord, save me" like Peter did?
- In a difficult season of life, how has God used a hard truth, whether from His Word or from a brother or sister who loves you, to strengthen your faith and call you to Himself? How did you respond to that correction?

### PRAYER

- The disciples in verse 32 worshipped Jesus by saying, "Truly you are the Son of God." In a similar way, as you pray, worship Him and praise Him for who He is. Ask Him to grow your faith as you obey, listen, trust, and yield to Him.
