NOTHING CAN STAND IN GOD'S WAY | AUGUST 9, 2026

SERMON RECAP

Nothing can stand in God's way, neither our self-righteousness and love of comfort, nor the hard hearts of those not yet following Him.

THE LEAD IN

- Share with your group about a time where you ended up in a situation where you felt out of place. How did you get there? What happened?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read through Acts 10. Why do you think the vision came to Peter three times? What did it take for him to realize what it was about and that God was sending him to the Gentiles?
- In Acts 11:1-18, we see the Jewish believers' response to Peter's visit to Cornelius. What do their actions and words say about what they believe? What causes their turn around?

GOING DEEPER

- Who, or what, have you allowed to become "unclean" in your mind? Who are the people you're grateful you're not like, or find hard to pray for? How has self-righteousness shaped the way you see them?
- God prepared the hearts of Peter and Cornelius before sending Peter on mission. Comfort is the enemy of growth and mission. What comforts are holding you back from bringing the gospel to your Oikos and other places God is calling you to?

PRAYER

- Spend time together praying for each person's Oikos, specifically those who don't yet know Christ.
