

MEMORIZATION TIPS & TRICKS

Pray. Ask the Helper for help!

We cannot stress **accountability** enough. Together is better!

Letter Method: Write the first letter of each word of the verse.

Place **index cards** with full verses around the house, in the car, and anywhere that you can see it. If it is easily accessible, you will be quicker to turn to it.

Shower Power: Rehearse every morning in the shower. (Hang your verses in Ziplock baggies on the walls!)

Building Block Repetition: Say verse 1, then verse 1 and 2, then verse 1, 2, 3. You get the idea.

Memorizing in the Car: Open the YouVersion Bible app and play the audio of the passage and say it with the reader.

Find an Audience: Practice in front of your kids and invite them to join along.

Write It Out!

Praying It: Praying God's Word is unstoppable. It takes God at his word and believes him for the fulfillment of it.

Pacing Matters: Slow and steady will help lock those verses in!

Create a **phone lock screen** of your verse on YouVersion.

Scripture Songs

Record yourself on an app on your phone and play it back repeatedly.

Write it on your **bathroom mirror**.

Reserve **5-10 minutes a day** to practice on the treadmill, in the shower, washing dishes, driving, etc.

Decorate: Calligraphy, doodling, drawing with kids, etc.

Dwell: Daily grace company scripture memory journal for expanded scripture memory.
