# SHEPHERD BIBLE STUDY

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth with intention and precision. He spoke galaxies into existence, formed mountains and valleys, filled the seas with life, and adorned the earth with things of various colors and shapes. He surveyed His creation, declaring it to be “very good” (Gen. 1:31).

Beholding the wonders of creation allows us to catch a glimpse of divine artistry. The vibrant hues of a sunset, the delicate intricacy of a butterfly’s wings, and the grandeur of mountain ranges—all bear witness to the God’s endless wisdom and creativity.

Getting caught up in the mundane moments of life can make it easy to overlook the beauty around us. But when we slow down enough to take in God’s creation, it’s hard not to be filled with awe and gratitude. Each sunrise, chirping bird, and rustling leaf speaks of the Creator’s love for us. God’s declaration that His creation is “very good” reminds us of the inherent worth of all He has made, including us.

Pause for a moment to step outside and behold the beauty of God’s creation. Whether you look at a single blade of grass or the expanse of the sky, remember it all reflects the goodness of our Creator, who made every bit of it with love.

# OUTLINE



## Arrival/Attendance/ Directed Play

10:40-11:05

Welcome the children and mark them as present on the attendance sheet on the clipboard by the door. Set up the activities and introduce the children to the lesson through these activities. Encourage the kids to participate in both activities as they play together. You may need to ask the kids to come to the different areas so all of them have the opportunity to participate

### Matching Memory Game

- Help the children to spread the cards out face down on the table in a grid pattern. Have the children take turns flipping over two cards at a time. If the cards match, the child keeps the pair. If they do not, the cards are flipped back over and it becomes the next child's turn. Repeat as time and interest allow.

### Creation Puzzle

- Help the children spread out all of the pieces face up on a table. Have the children work as a team to assemble the pieces to discover the hidden picture! The puzzle will be 5 pieces across and 4 pieces tall when finished.

## Clean Up and Gather for Story

11:05-11:10

Invite the children to begin cleaning up toys and putting away their activities at 9:10. Then remind them to meet at the carpet for Bible story time. Remind the children that we are going to do our best to be good listeners.





## Bible Story

11:10-11:25

### Welcome Song

- Welcome all the children by singing their welcome song
- (Tune of Twinkle Twinkle Little Star)
- Welcome, Welcome Everyone
- Now you're here Let's have some fun
- First let's clap our hands like so
- Then reach down and touch our toes
- Welcome, Welcome Everyone
- Now you're here Let's have some fun
  - You can call a group of children names to welcome them and they can stand up and wave if you'd like.

Then begin telling today's story. You can use Spark Bible pgs. 2-7 or you can use the visual pictures for each day of creation from your bin. If you choose to use the handheld pictures, the words to the story are below.

- Before God created the world, there was nothing at all--except God. On the first day of creation, the wind of God blew. **WHISH! WOOSH! SWOOSH!** God said, "Let there be light!" **CRACKLE! BOOM! BANG!** There was light. God saw that the light was good. Then, **SPLLLLLLIITTT!** God divided the light and darkness into day and night. On the second day, God said, "Let there be a sky!" **PILLOW! BILLOW! PUFF!** There was a sky. God saw that the sky was good. On the third day, God said, "Let there be water and dry land!" **DRIP! DROP! KERPLUNK!** There was water. **CRACKLE! CRUNCH! SNAP!** There was dry land. God saw that the water and land were good. Then God said, "Let there be plants and trees!" **RUMBLE! RUSTLE! POP!** There were plants and trees. God saw the plants and trees were good. On the fourth day, God said, "Let there be a sun and a moon and stars!" **GLIMMER! SHIMMER! SHINE!** There was a sun and a moon and thousands of stars. God saw that the sun and the moon and stars were good. On the fifth day, God said, "Let there be sea animals that swim and birds that fly!" **WIGGLE! SPLISH! SPLASH!** There were sea animals. **FLUTTER! PUTTER! TWEET!** There were birds. God saw that the sea animals and birds were good. On the sixth day, God said, "Let there be animals of every kind on the earth!"
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- **GROWL! PROWL! SNORT!** There were animals with fur. **SKITTER! SKATTER!** There were bugs. **SLITHER, SLINK, HOP!** There were reptiles. God saw that the animals and bugs and reptiles were good. Then God said, "Let there be people on the earth!" **BLINK! WINK! HICCUP!** There were people on the earth. God saw that the people were very good. On the seventh day, God said, "It is time to rest!" **WHEW! PSHEW! AHHH!** God and all creation rested.

## Craft/Coloring Page

11:25-11:35

After the story, have the children go to their tables and prepare for a craft to go along with the lesson. Our **BIG IDEA** of the week is: God created all things!

Distribute the Genesis 1:1 Tree craft page to the children. Using the stickers in your room, allow each child to pick 4 stickers that represent something God created, and stick it to their tree. While the children are waiting for stickers, or after they have already placed their stickers, place crayons on each table to further color the tree. As the children pick stickers, ask them questions to review the story. (Which day did God make birds? What did God make on the second day? What did God say about the things he made each day? Etc.)

As children finish the tree, distribute the coloring page with the Creation story on the back for children to continue coloring. have the children place both the craft and coloring sheet in their bin when they are finished.

## Friends from Afar

## Songs/Memory Verse/Prayer

11:45-11:55

Using the Song sheet in your bin, lead children in singing "He's Got the Whole World in His Hands" and "This is the Day"

- There are also a list of songs for today's lesson on the TV. Use the directions located with the remote to access them.

**Prayer** (Use these words, or your own, to pray about today's Bible lesson. Take time to listen to prayer requests from the children and pray for them as well!)

- Dear Heavenly Father, thank you for creating everything. We are so thankful and amazed by your creation. Help us to tell others about all of your amazing creation. In your name we pray, Amen!

### Memory Verse

- "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." Genesis 1:1
- Teach the children the motions for this verse
  - In the beginning- point to your watch (or pretend if you aren't wearing a watch)
  - God created- squeeze your hands together like you are making something out of play dough
  - The heavens- Raise your hands high and wiggle your fingers
  - and the earth- put your hands on the ground
  - Genesis 1:1- hold up one finger on each hand as you say the numbers
- Have the kids join you in saying the verse and doing the motions several times to practice. Ask the children if anyone would like to do the verse on their own. If someone needs help, have them pick a friend or do it with them. If no one volunteers, repeat as a class twice more.

## Snack Time at Tables

11:55-12:05

Prior to serving the snack have the children use hand sanitizer before choosing a seat at the table. Each child will have veggie straws on a napkin and a small cup of water. **NOTE:** some children with allergies will have their own snack or drink...parents usually remind shepherds of this at drop off. If a question, please contact Kid Min Staff in hallways. Thanks.

While the children are eating their snack, please read the read aloud book that is in the bin labeled Read Aloud book for snack time. Thanks.





## Free Choice Play

12:05-12:15

Once the snack and read aloud are finished, the children may choose free play until their parents come to pick them up.

At dismissal, please make sure to check the child's tag number to match the parent's tag. Have the children take home any papers from their bin. Finally, check them off the attendance as being picked up (the last column for the date).
