

Passing the Baton - Part 5 The Goal and Motivation of Sanctification II Timothy 4:8

Big Truth of this Series: The apostle Paul encourages and warns Timothy and all believers to follow, entrust, and be always ready to proclaim God's Word with confidence and joy as days of difficulty lie ahead.

Big Truth of Today's Message: Paul reminds Timothy and all believers that there is a coming Day when all will meet the Lord Jesus face to face as the righteous judge. He will award the crown of righteousness to those who "have loved His appearing."

v. 8 – "Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness,

which the Lord, the righteous judge,

will award to me on that Day,

and not only to me but also to all who have loved His appearing."
