

Flee Sin, Pursue Godliness, and Fight the Good Fight I Timothy 6:11-16

Big Truth of this Series: God has commissioned the people of God, the church, to be grounded in sound doctrine and to live in a godly manner according to His truth.

Big Truth of Today's Message: The man or woman of God runs from sin and pursues godly character by fighting the good fight of the faith, taking hold of eternal life, and keeping his or her commission with complete integrity.

- 11 But as for you, O man of God, flee these things. Pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, steadfastness, gentleness.
- 12 Fight the good fight of the faith.

Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called and about which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.
