How to Be a Leader and a Man of Valor

Nehemiah 11:1-26

Big Truth of this Series: God is working to glorify Himself by sending a deliverer to rebuild our broken walls and call us to worship and obedience in the face of opposition.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: God-fearing and God-following men take the responsibility to lead themselves, their families and God’s people.

Introduction:

Leaders commit to lead by example; willing workers and notable nobodies. (11:1-6)

Leaders are “mighty men of valor” who perform holy housework. (11:7-16)

Leaders lead in worship by praying, singing, and giving thanks. (11:17-18, 20-24; 12:8, 24)

Leaders are gatekeepers. (11:19; 12:25)
