The Servant King

John 13:1-17

With the shadow of the cross looming ever larger before Him, Jesus stoops to display His love for His disciples. The King of Glory, who possesses all authority and power, willingly embraces the role of a lowly servant by washing His disciples' feet. Yet this act of cleansing is only a sign of the greater work He is about to accomplish—the cleansing of His people's sin through His sacrificial death. In doing so, Jesus establishes the pattern His people are to follow. Having been cleansed by Christ, we, as His followers, are called to imitate His humble love in serving one another, for "if you know these things, blessed are you if you do them" (John 13:17).

Questions to Consider

Why did Jesus choose to give this lesson on humility and service on the night before His crucifixion?

How is the love of Christ shaping you now?

Since Jesus's humble service is the pattern for His people, what would it look like to follow His example in the practical areas of your life?

What does your willingness or unwillingness to serve others reveal about how deeply you have understood the heart of your Master?
