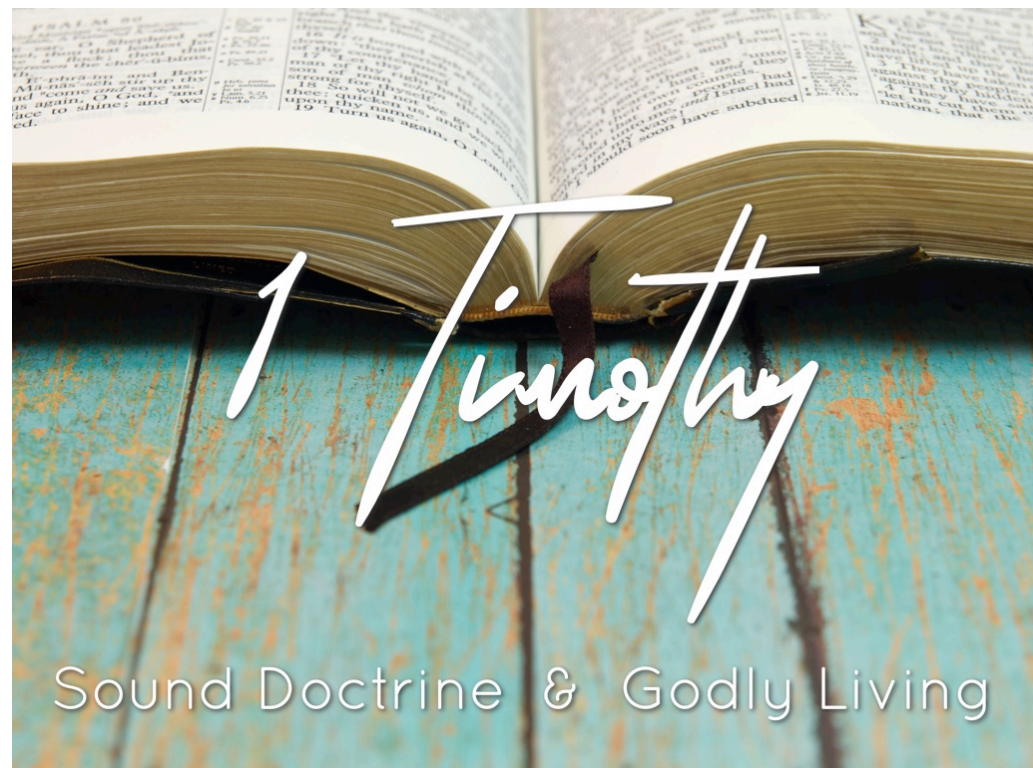
Choir & Orchestra Rehearsal, Wed. Feb. 8, 6:30-7:30pm

“Although Father and Son are the same in essence and equally God, they function in different roles. By God’s own design, the Son submits to the Father’s leadership.
