

II Timothy 2:1-2

Big Truth of this Series: The apostle Paul encourages and warns Timothy and all believers to follow, entrust, and be always ready to proclaim God's Word with confidence and joy as days of difficulty lie ahead.

Big Truth of Today's Message: We are to be strengthened by grace to hold fast (grip) God's Word, guard it at all costs, and then give it away to other reliable and competent Christ-followers.

v. 1 – "You then, my child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus..."

v. 2a – "...and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses..."

v. 2b - "...entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also."
