“Future worry is overwhelming. There’s a reason. We don’t have grace today for tomorrow. He Is All You’ll Ever Need, Part 6
His Name Shall Be Called Prince of Peace
Isaiah 9:6

Big Truth of this Series: The prophet Isaiah foretold of the coming Messiah who would deliver His people and who would be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: What is God’s answer to the darkest times in life? In a way that we would not expect, God has sent His deliverer, the Messiah, and His name shall be called Prince of Peace.

v. 6a – “*For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called...Prince of Peace!*”

Romans 5:1-5

v. 1 – Peace *with* God leads to the peace *of* God.

v. 2a – Peace with God gives *access* to God.

v. 2b – Peace with God guarantees the *hope* of the glory of God.

v. 3 – Peace with God grants *joy* in suffering.

v. 5 – Peace with God *assures* us of God’s love.
