The Lord’s Supper will be observed **January 22** during the worship service. We do this in remembrance of the Lord, and thus proclaim His death until He comes.

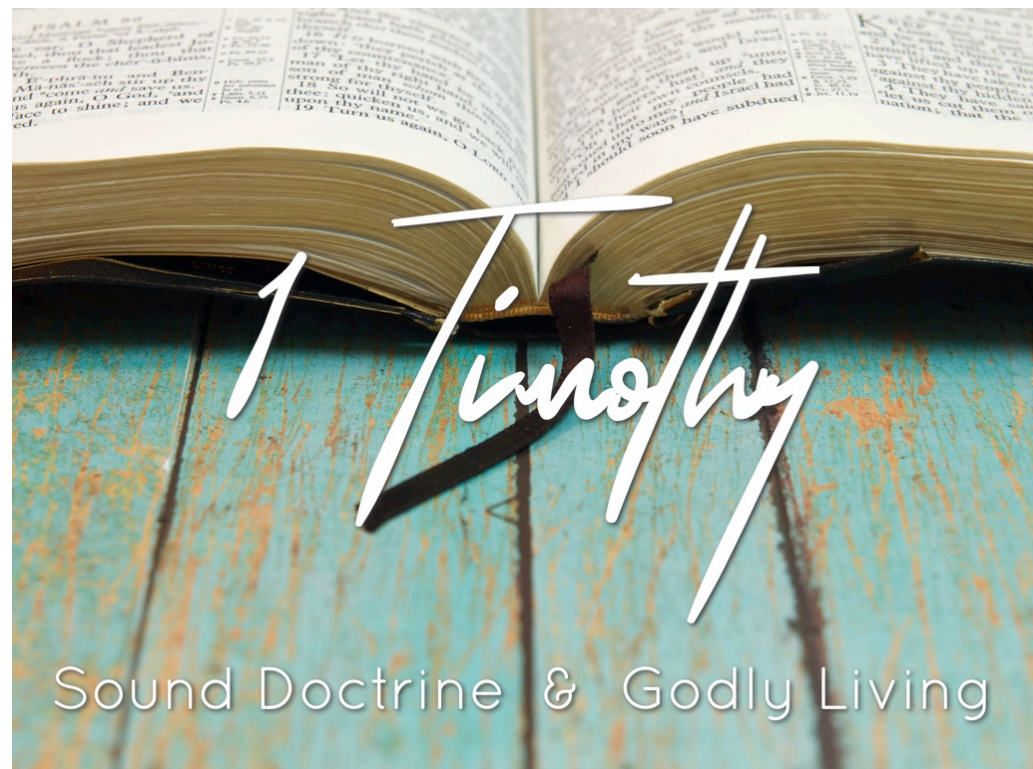

**Preeminence of Jesus Christ as
the Only Mediator
I Timothy 2:5-7**

Big Truth of this Series: God has commissioned the people of God, the church, to be grounded in sound doctrine and to live in a godly manner according to the truth.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: A healthy church teaches and proclaims unapologetically that Jesus Christ is the only Mediator between God and men.

5 For there is one God,

and there is one mediator between God and men,

the man Christ Jesus,

6 who gave himself as a ransom for all,

which is the testimony given at the proper time.

7 For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying), a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.
