# Safe and Secure in the Father's Hand

**John 10:22-30**

The Jews remain uncertain about Jesus's identity, prompting them to question Him once more. Jesus explains that their unbelief stems from the fact that they are not His sheep. His sheep hear His voice and follow Him. His sheep are safe and secure in His hand. Indeed, that is the great promise to His flock: that we will never be lost. This is not because of our grip on Him, but because of His unbreakable hold on us. When we rightly understand this truth about our eternal security, we cannot help but rejoice.

1. Suspense (v. 24)

## Questions to Consider

Do I truly recognize Jesus as the Good Shepherd, or is my belief still uncertain, like the Jews in the passage?

When Jesus says, "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me," what does this mean for us?

2. Sheep (vv. 25-27)

Do I truly believe that I am safe in Jesus's hand, or do I live with fear and insecurity? If I am truly secure and safe in Jesus's hand, how should that lead me toward obedience and love for him?

3. Security (v. 28)

How does this passage deepen my understanding of Jesus as the Good Shepherd, and how should this understanding affect my evangelism and discipleship?

4. Sovereignty (vv. 29-30)
