The Way to Glory

John 12:20-26

For the first time in John's Gospel, Jesus declares that His 'hour' has finally come. The arrival of some Greeks signals that the time has arrived for the Son of Man to be glorified. Yet, true to the paradoxical nature of Christ and His kingdom, His glory will be revealed through His death. Like a grain of wheat that falls into the earth and dies to produce a great harvest, Jesus must die in order to bring life to many. The path of the Master then becomes the pattern for His disciples: we die in order to live, lose in order to gain, and serve Christ in order to receive the Father's honor.
