**A Troubled Soul and an
Unshakable Purpose
John 12:27-36**

Jesus's soul is deeply troubled as His hour (His suffering and death) arrives. He is resolute in His purpose despite the weight of what He is enduring. Facing the cross, His concern is the glory of the Father, just as it has always been. Because He is the Light, we must believe in the Light and walk in the Light, that we may become children of Light.

Questions to Consider

Verse 28 is the only time that John mentions the Father speaking in this gospel. Why does the Father choose this moment to speak from heaven? What does His voice confirm about Jesus and His mission?

What does Jesus' response to His coming suffering reveal about His identity—and about true discipleship?

Are you simply aware of the Light, or have you believed in Him and are you walking in Him?

What can we learn from Jesus's response to suffering? How should His example shape our own response to suffering?
