## **Saints and Sinners - Part 4**

**II Timothy 4:14-22**

**Big Truth of this Series:** The apostle Paul encourages and warns Timothy and all believers to follow, entrust, and be always ready to proclaim God’s Word with confidence and joy as days of difficulty lie ahead.

**Big Truth of Today’s Message:** God uses every relationship in our lives, some encouraging and others discouraging, to shape us into the image of Christ.

v. 14-15 – You will have enemies. Refuse revenge and let the Lord deal with them.

v. 16 – Friends will fail you. Forgive them. Never hold anything against them.

v. 19-22, 17-18 – You will have some forever friends, but Jesus alone is your perfect friend who will stand with you and strengthen you.
