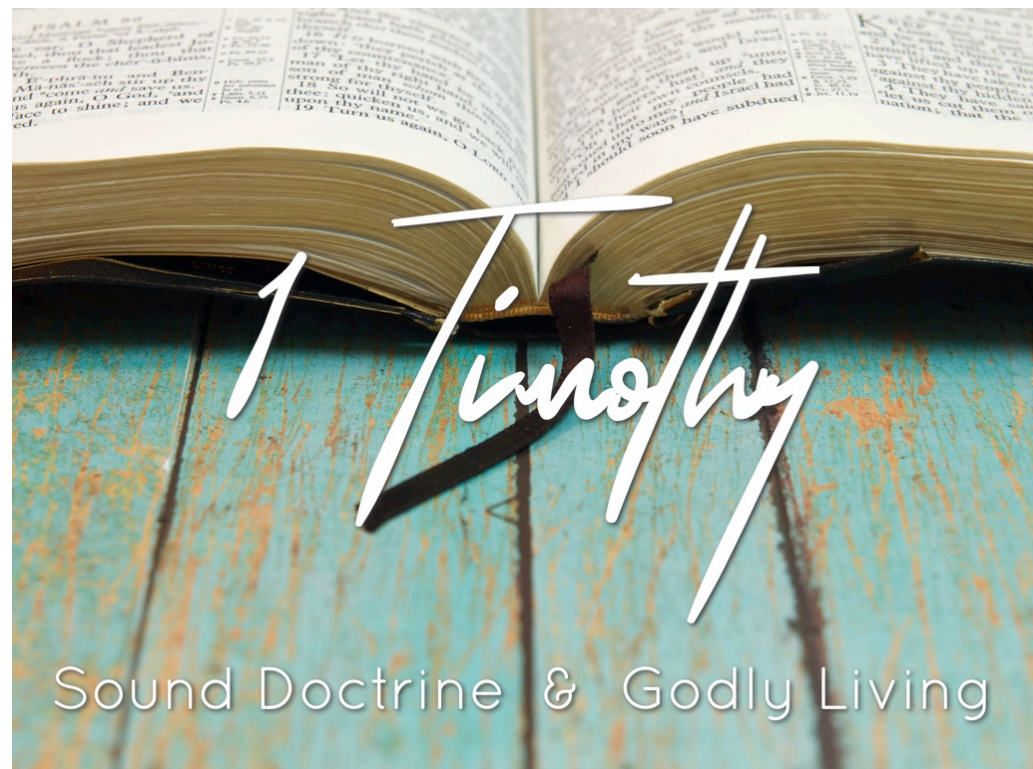
Save The Date! May 28 at 5pm for HBC Picnic at Mitch Park.

I Timothy 3:14-15

Big Truth of this Series: God has commissioned the people of God, the church, to be grounded in sound doctrine and to live in a godly manner according to His truth.

Big Truth of Today's Message: The apostle Paul summarizes the purpose of writing to Timothy and the church at Ephesus: Gospel-centered living that supports God's truth.

The written Word of God tells us everything we need to know for life and godliness. (3:14)

The greatness of the church as the *household* of God. (3:15)

The greatness of the church as the church of *the living God*. (3:15)

The greatness of the church as *the pillar and foundation of the truth*. (3:15)
