Additional Sermon Notes:

Human Unbelief and Heavenly Authority

John 7:1-24

Jesus faces growing hostility and unbelief from the world—even from His own brothers—while remaining fully committed to the Father’s will. Rather than acting on human pressure, He moves according to God’s timing, going up to the feast in quiet, deliberate obedience. At the feast, He teaches publicly with authority, making clear that His doctrine comes from God, not Himself. He then exposes the hypocrisy of the people’s judgment, calling them to move beyond superficial appearances and to judge with true righteousness.
