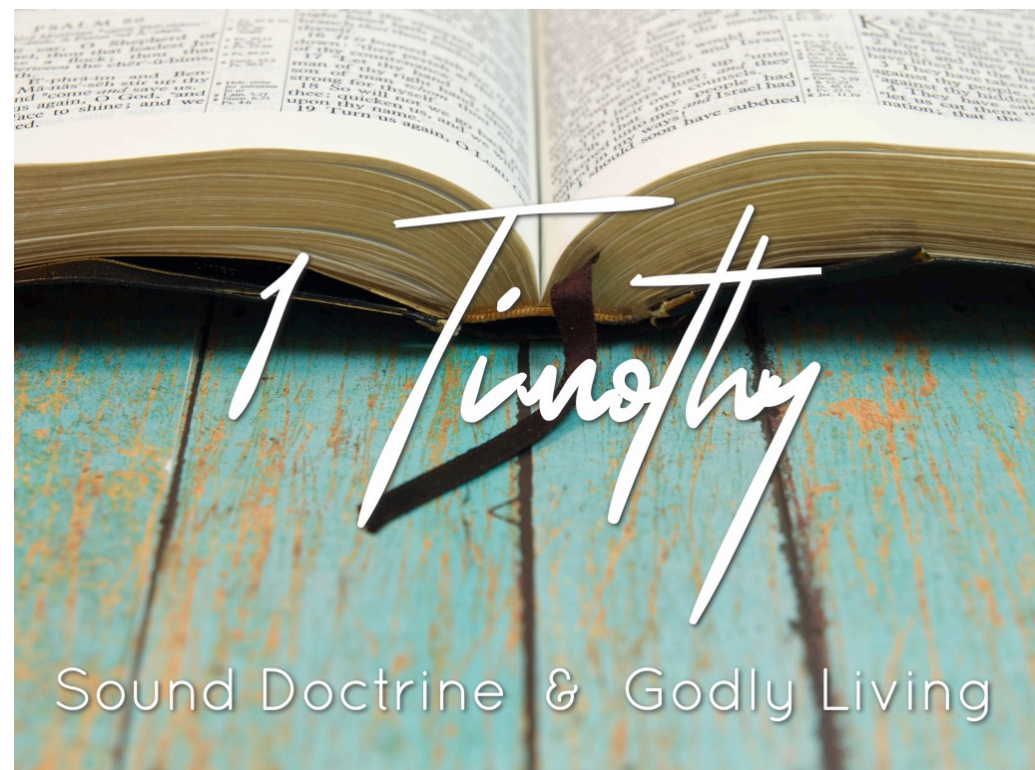

Dealing with False Teachers &

False Doctrine – Part 2

I Timothy 1:6-11

Big Truth of this Series: God has commissioned the people of God, the church, to be grounded in sound doctrine and to live in a godly manner according to the truth.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: False teachers pervert the good Law of God which, when used correctly, is used by God to confront sin and lead sinners to the gospel of the glory of the blessed God.

- 6 Certain persons, by swerving from these, have wandered away into vain discussion,
- 7 desiring to be teachers of the law, without understanding either what they are saying or the things about which they make confident assertions.
- 8 Now we know that the law is good, if one uses it lawfully,
- 9 understanding this, that the law is not laid down for the just but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and sinners, for the unholy and profane,
- for those who strike their fathers and mothers, for murderers,
- 10 the sexually immoral, men who practice homosexuality, enslavers, liars, perjurers,
- and whatever else is contrary to sound doctrine,
- 11 in accordance with the gospel of the glory of the blessed God with which I have been entrusted.
