

Dealing with False Teachers & False Doctrine – Part I I Timothy 1:3-5

Big Truth of this Series: God has commissioned the people of God (the church) to be grounded in sound doctrine and to live in a godly manner according to the truth.

Big Truth of Today's Message: False teachers are a constant threat to the spiritual health of Christians and the church and must be confronted and stopped.

Vs. 3 As I (when I was going to Macedonia) urged you, remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach...

...any different doctrine...

Vs. 4 ...nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies, which promote speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith.

Vs. 5 The aim of our charge is **love**... that issues from...

... a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.
