

Jonah – Salvation Belongs to the Lord The Prayer of a Desperate Man Jonah 2:1-9

Big Truth of this Series: From beginning to end, salvation is of the Lord! God's holy justice is balanced with His magnificent grace and mercy and is extended to everyone who believes the gospel message, repents, and turns to Him.

Big Truth of Today's Message: What do you do when you are in deep distress? Jonah cried out to his God in his desperation and believed He promised to hear and answer.

- v. 1-2 Jonah cried out to the Lord His God from the depths of darkness. God heard and answered his prayer.
- v. 3-4a, 5-6a Jonah saw God's sovereign plan at work in his desperate situation.
- v. 4b, 6b, 7b Jonah saw God's hand of deliverance for His divine purposes.

v. 7-9 – Jonah remembered the Lord and that salvation comes from Him.
