The God of Second Chances and His Wrath Against the Godless

Jonah 2:10-3:4

Big Truth of this Series: From beginning to end, salvation is of the Lord! God’s holy justice is balanced with His magnificent grace and mercy and is extended to everyone who believes the gospel message, repents, and turns to Him.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: God graciously gave Jonah a second chance to obey Him and proclaim His gospel message to the godless Ninevites.

vs. 2:10-3:1 – After Jonah prayed, repented, and renewed himself to God’s purpose, God again commissioned him to take His message to the Ninevites.

vs. 3:2, 4b – God was very specific that Jonah was to take His message.

vs. 3:3-4a – Jonah was faithful to obey God’s call to go and proclaim His message.
