THE GRATITUDE OF A FISHER OF MEN

1Thessalonians 5:16-18

16 Rejoice always,

17 Pray without ceasing,

18 Give thanks in all circumstances

V. 16 - Rejoice Always (NOT Carelessly)

- Acts 5 Persecuted Apostles counted it JOY to suffer for the Name of Christ, as He did.
- Hebrews 12:2 Jesus counted the Cross JOY
- Matthew 5:11-12 Sermon on the Mount Jesus find JOY when people insult, persecute, speak falsely about you for God's Sake REJOICE!

Philippians 4:4 - Rejoice in the Lord always and again I say Rejoice!

V17 - Pray without Ceasing (NOT Conditional)

- Matthew 6:7-13 Sermon on the Mount Jesus is saying "when we pray!" Pray to the Father
- Hebrew 4:14-16 Jesus sympathizes He was tempted in everyway without NOT sin Grace and Mercy! Jesus has Authority
- Ephesians 6:18 Be anxious for NOTHING Pray always in the Spirit Helper in times of need
 - Colossians 4:2 Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving.

V. 18 - Give thanks in all circumstances

- (NOT Circumstantial)

Romans 5:8 - Rejoice in Suffering - Produces Endurance

Philippians 4:11-13 - I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do all this through him who gives me strength.

18...for this is the Will of God in Christ Jesus for you.



Will of God -

- Romans 12:2 Do not be conformed to the World but be Transformed -Renewing of your mind.
- 1 Corinthians 2:16 Who can understand Him???
 But we have the Mind of Christ!
- Mark 3:35 Whoever does the Will of God Christ sees as family (*Brother, Sister, Mother*)
- 1 Peter 2:15 For this is the will of God, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people.
