

# Bible in the Bible

**Moses:** Great Shema (Deuteronomy 6:4–5)

*“The word of the Lord came to me..”* (Prophets)

**Jesus:** Introduced as The Word, Introduces Himself as The Word, Says He Came to Fulfil the Law (Gospels)

**Apostles:** Commandment & Commission – Bridge OT & NT  
(Matthew 22:37-39 & Matthew 28:19-20)

**Paul:** Refers the Word as “God-Breathed (2 Timothy 3:16)

## What It Does?

For the Word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. - Hebrews 4:12

**Living – It is the Living Word of God**

**Two-Edged Sword – Offensive to us**

**Dividing – NOT surface-level changes**

**Discerning – Reveals who we really are**

# Psalm 1

**1 Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers;**

**2 but his delight is in the Law of the Lord, and on His Law he meditates day and night.**



**3 He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers.**

**4 The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away.**


**5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous;**

**6 for the Lord knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.**
