“The word of the Lord came to me..” (Prophets)


Jesus: Introduced as The Word, Introduces Himself as The Word, Says He Came to Fulfil the Law (**Gospels**)

What Is It?

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness. - 2 Timothy 3:16



What It Does?

For the Word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. - Hebrews 4:12

Living – It is the Living Word of God

Two-Edged Sword – Offensive to us

Dividing – NOT surface-level changes

Discerning – Reveals who we really are


Why It Does?

Psalm 1

1 Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers;


2 but his delight is in the Law of the Lord, and on His Law he meditates day and night.
