Dragnet - Gospel

- Goes Through All the Sea & Collects Everything
 - Good Fish & Bad Fish Together – Pulled to Shore
- The Task of Sorting – at the End – is the Purpose!
 - Keep the “Good” – Get Rid of the “Bad”

Gospel in the World & Church

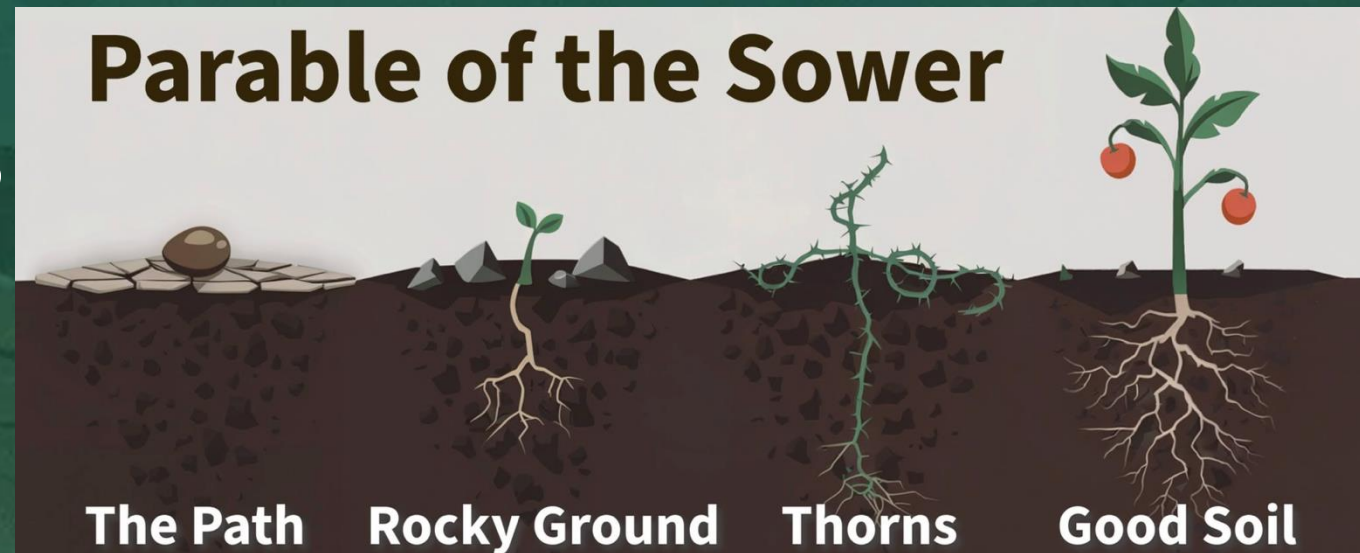
Gospel Will be Heard... "He said to them, 'Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.'" - Mark 16:15
