

Joshua 1:5b-7

^{5b} I will not leave you nor forsake you. ⁶ Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. ⁷ Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.

⁸ This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. Change

- 1. New seasons
- 2. Uncertain futures
- 3. Letting go of the familiar and stepping into the unknown

God is not only aware of your change;
He is already in it.

Courage

- He wasn't stepping into comfort
- He was stepping into a challenge

God doesn't just give him encouragement — He gives him a command: "Be strong and courageous."

Transformation

- Sometimes change is God's way of repositioning you for greater impact
- Sometimes He closes a door not to punish you, but to protect you and redirect you.
- Through transformation, we begin to see: "Oh…that's why that had to happen."

Change might look like a detour, but in God's hands, it's a setup for destiny.

Purpose

- · God's pattern says: "if it's My will, embrace it."

Renewal happens when you surrender your thoughts, fears, expectations, and allow God's Word to reshape them.
