Old Testament Tabernacle/Temple

Physical spaces represented God's covenant with Israel and God's presence with them. A place for worship, repentance, sacrifice, & fellowship.

New Testament Temple

YOU and the CHURCH are now the temple.

Built on the foundation of Jesus Christ!

We worship, fellowship, plant! God makes it grow!

Anyone who builds on that foundation may use a variety of materials—gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. But on the judgment day, fire will reveal what kind of work each builder has done. The fire will show if a person's work has any value.

1 Corinthians 3:12-13 (NLT)

Don't put your faith, hope, and trust in things that are temporal! Focus most on the eternal!

A life built on earthly things..... will not last, is not very safe, and will usually need a lot of fixing.



Is this something that God would want or allow in His Holy Temple?




