WHERE ARE MY AFFECTIONS?

Full Heart – Full Hand | Acts 4:32-37



Evidence of running on empty

Pride and Selfish Ambition – When people prioritize their own recognition, status, or preferences over the good of others

Unresolved Conflict – Bitterness, grudges, and avoidance of healthy reconciliation create division and mistrust.

Gossip and Negative Speech – Talking about others instead of to them spreads suspicion and damages trust.

Favoritism and Cliques – Excluding or elevating certain groups over others fractures community and breeds resentment.

Lack of Shared Mission or Vision – Without a unifying purpose, individuals drift into personal agendas instead of pulling together toward a common goal.

Evidence of being filled by the Spirit

Shared Heart and Mind – Acts 4:32 says believers were of “one heart and soul,” showing deep agreement in love and mission.

Mutual Care – Acts 2:44-45 and Acts 4:34-35 describe believers willingly sharing possessions so that “there was not a needy person among them.”

Devotion to Worship & Fellowship Together- Acts 1:14 & Acts 2:42 show the early church continually gathering for prayer, teaching, fellowship, and breaking of bread.

Harmony Despite Diversity – 1 Corinthians 12:12-13 teaches that though believers are many and different, they form one body through the Spirit.

Peaceful Reconciliation – Eph. 4:2-3 calls believers to humility, gentleness, patience, and bearing with one another in love, eager to “maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.”
