Reformation Sunday: October 26, 2025

"More than 500 years ago, the Protestant Reformation brought the church's focus back to God's free gift of salvation in Jesus Christ. On Oct 31, 1517, Martin Luther posted the 95 Theses - the "Disputation on the Power and Efficacy of Indulgences" - to the church door in a small city called Wittenberg, Germany. This event ignited the Protestant Reformation, thus the Lutheran church officially commemorates this important anniversary on Oct 31. The Reformation was, first and foremost, all about the Gospel of Jesus Christ. It was then, and it still is now. The task of reformation never ends.
