Year end results were reviewed and discussed. St. Paul ended the year with a surplus of \$31,841, which has been added to the Ministry Development Fund. The Gathering Place ended the year with a \$50,028 deficit, which was funded by its dedicated account. The year end results do not reflect the impact of the Payroll Protection Plan loan funds. While the funds were fully utilized before year-end, the loan is not yet "forgiven". Information on the mechanics of loan forgiveness is not yet known. At the start of the fiscal year each "called" employee attributes a portion of wages to housing. The decisions, based on individual circumstances and tax status, do not impact the cost to the church. Policy #54 – Ministry Development Fund	This policy describes that the fund is intended for any and all of the following purposes: 1) ministry expansion; 2) providing "giving gap" funding should a deficit occur in general operations at year end; and 3) a source of payroll funding should another pandemic shutdown of all or portions of the ministry be necessary. Church employees are excluded from WI Unemployment Insurance coverage.
