Greetings Parents of 6<sup>th</sup> grade confirmation student

Please read through all of the materials included in this mailing regarding the upcoming confirmation retreat, Seder meal, and 1<sup>st</sup> communion.

**Communion Retreat & Purpose:** All baptized 6<sup>th</sup> graders who have participated in confirmation instruction are invited to join us March 6-7, 2026 at Camp Y-Koda in Sheboygan Falls. During our time at Camp Y-Koda we will dig deep into God's Word as we explore Communion and what it means for individuals who believe in Christ. Students will learn what it means to partake in this special sacrament given to us by our Lord and Savior. In addition, all participants will have a ton of fun with games and interactive community builders. This time of learning is in combination with the Seder meal and 1<sup>st</sup> Communion event that will take place on Tuesday, March 10<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.

**Camp Y-Koda:** located easily off of Hwy 23. W3340 Sunset Road, Sheboygan Falls, WI. We will be staying in Johnson Lodge, please follow the signs once on the grounds. All participants are asked to arrive at the camp by **6:00pm on Friday, March 6**. *Please note-* supper is not served but snacks will be shared throughout the evening so plan accordingly. All students can be picked up at the camp the following day **Saturday, March 7 at 2:00 pm**.

*\*\*\*PLEASE speak with me if you would like your son/daughter to participate but have sporting or musical events happening that weekend as well. I will work around any schedule!*

**Not ready yet:** The ultimate choice to attend this retreat and receive Holy Communion lies with you, THE PARENTS. You know the faith development of your child the best. For those students who are unable to attend or are not ready at this point in time, this retreat is offered yearly.

**Packing List:** Please note the packing list for the retreat. (enclosed) Electronic items should be kept at home. The risk of something breaking is likely and St Paul will not be responsible for the replacement of any items. So, it is best just to keep those items at home! If a child has prescribed medication they are to take, it should be turned in to the adult leader upon arrival at check-in.

**Participants:** Confirmants who completed the necessary work to participate in their 1<sup>st</sup> Communion. This event is for the confirmant and parents. Please indicate on the registration form the total number of people attending (if 1 or both parents will be attending). We encourage you to talk about your experience with extended family and siblings after the event, but they are not able to attend.

**Purpose:** During this special meal we will learn how the Old Testament Passover pointed to and was fulfilled in Jesus. As we participate in the Passover meal called "Seder" we will relive the same meal the Israelites participated in, and the same meal Jesus and the 12 disciples partook.
