## Hello AWANA Parent(s)!

We are so excited that your child will be joining us for **AWANA** this year. On the back side of this sheet, you will find theme nights and other items to note. Your child is welcome to dress up for theme nights to earn extra points for the AWANA store. Also please be sure to note the days when no class is held or class is ending early. If class needs to be canceled due to weather, please watch for a text that will be sent to you.

**Drop off and pick up-** AWANA is held every **Wednesday at 6pm**. All students start in the Fellowship Hall. Parents are welcome to bring their child in or drop off at the main doors. Only the main doors are open on Wednesday evenings. AWANA will dismiss from the **Worship Center at 7:30pm**. Parents are always welcome to attend large group closing which begins around 7:10pm. All parents need to come inside the building to pick up their child. If your child has a sibling in confirmation, they can escort your child out. The parking lot can get very busy on Wednesday nights with other ministry events taking place. So please use caution when coming and going.

**AWANA books-** We have equipped you, the parents, with your child's AWANA handbook/binder. This book/binder should be looked at and gone through every week. You are encouraged to read over the materials and study the key scripture memory work passage. Each week, your child is welcome to recite their memory work to our memory work monitors. Once the memory work monitors sign off, they are welcome to move on to the next section. These handbooks are gifted to you. If your child loses their book, they are allowed one replacement. After that, any lost materials will need to be purchased.

**Bibles-** are given to all our 3rd graders at the beginning of the year. If your child did not receive a Bible this year, please see Savannah.

**Offering-** will be collected at opening time as your child enters the fellowship hall. If your son/daughter would like to bring an offering every week, they are welcome to do so. All offerings will go to Operation Christmas Child.

**Visitors are welcome-** Relatives and friends are always welcome to join your child's AWANA small group. Please let us know when you bring a visitor and if a visitor becomes a regular attendee, we will ask the parents to complete a registration form.
