First Paragraph:

My prayers are with you concerning XXX/yourself. May this card bring you some comfort in knowing that others are praying with him/her/you.

Second Paragraph:

If you know nothing about the person:

May God look upon you with XXX/you with the eyes of mercy and comfort him/her/you with a sense of thy goodness. May the power of prayer help to restore some inner peace to him/her/you during this time of need.

If the prayer is for a church member and know nothing about the reason:

"And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who are called according to His purpose." (Romans 8:28)

If the prayer is per a member's request for another person & know nothing of the reason:

"God comforts us when we have trouble so when others have trouble, we can comfort them with the same comfort God gave us." (2 Corinthians 1:4)

If they are sick:

"And the prayer that is said with faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will heal that person." (James 5:15)

If the person has cancer:

"Our soul waits for the Lord; he is our help and our shield, for our heart is glad in him, because we trust in his holy name. Let your steadfast love, O Lord, be upon us, even as we hope in you." (Psalms 33:20-22)

If the person is terminal:

"Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for Thou art with me." (Psalms 23:4)
