- 2. The Father is the Vine Dresser
- 3. You and I are the Branches

I. THE PROCESS OF BEING LIKE HIM

A. The purging of sin

Read John 15:2a

B. The pruning of self

To "prune" = to thin, to reduce, to cut off

The branch that is not attached to the vine is useless
