*"Little is much when God is in it."*

Today we come to the fourth miracle recorded in John – the feeding of the 5,000. It's the only miracle recorded in all four Gospels. It must have been quite a sight – and it provided an eternal lesson for us all.

---

### I. THE PROBLEM NOT TOO BIG TO SOLVE

#### A. The People Had No Food

Jesus, seeing the multitude, saw people with needs, no direction, heartache, sorrow, and grief – and He was moved with compassion.

#### B. The Disciples Had No Faith – vv. 5–9

There is no panic in Heaven, only plans. Jesus already knew what He was going to do. He simply wanted Philip to learn something about Philip – and about Jesus.

### II. THE PERSON NOT TOO SMALL TO USE – vv. 9–12

God used a young boy because of two things:

#### A. He Gave Self

*"For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it."* – [Mark 8:35](#)

God delights in taking ordinary people and doing extraordinary things through them.

#### B. He Gave Substance

He had so little – just a poor man's lunch of bread and fish. It seemed too small to be useful. But **little is big when God is in it.**

*"Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over..."* – [Luke 6:38](#)

Little is much when God is in it.

### III. THE PICTURE NOT TOO HARD TO SEE

Jesus can meet the deeper, spiritual hunger of our hearts.

A. Jesus Is Spiritual Bread – vv. 25–29

People need more than soup and soap. They need salvation.

B. Jesus Is Supernatural Bread – v. 30

C. Jesus Is Satisfying Bread – v. 35

Our world tries frantically to satisfy the hunger in their soul – through pills, possessions, position, popularity, prestige. It has always been this way.
