One of the greatest examples of an encourager: Barnabas

Barnabas practiced the principle of bearing one another's burdens
He knew the difference between ownership and stewardship
"It's not the seed that's kept in the barn that increased: it's the seed that's invested that increases."

Paul the Persecutor (Read <u>Acts 9:1-2</u>)
God takes the least likely – and makes a trophy of grace. (Read <u>Acts 9:23-27</u>)
