## Introduction:

Psalm 145 Background

- -The last Psalm attributed to David and most likely written toward the end of David's life
- -One of the nine Psalms that uses a Hebrew form of poetry called *an acrostic* because each verse egins with a letter in the Hebrew alphabet.
- -This is the only Psalm that starts with a Praise of David.
- -Some have called this particular Psalm, David's swan song.
- -It seems fitting that David would systematically and theologically, write a *Psalms of Praise!*

## I. David Declares His Praise

- a. He declares his resolve to give praise (Psalm 145:1)
- b. He declares his resilience to give praise (Psalm 145:2)



## II. David Expresses His Praise

He expresses praise for God's GREATNESS (Psalm 145:3-6)

- a. God's greatness is unsearchable
- b. God's greatness is unparallel
- c. God's greatness is unfathomable
- d. God's greatness is <u>unbelievable</u>



He expresses praise for God's GOODNESS Psalm 145:7, Psalm 145:9-10)

- a. God's goodness overflows the heart.
- b. God's goodness  $\underline{\text{overshadows}}$  His creation.
- c. God's goodness overwhelms the saints.

He expresses praise for God's <b>GRACIOUSNESS</b> ( <u>Psalm 145:8</u> )
a. God's graciousness is <u>kind</u>
b. God's graciousness is patient
He expresses praise for God's <b>GLORY</b> (Psalm 145:11-13)
a. God's glorious <u>authority</u>
b. God's glorious <u>sovereignty</u>
c. God's glorious <u>eternality</u>
He expresses praise for God's <b>GENEROSITY</b> ( <u>Psalm 145:14-20</u> )
a. God <u>supports</u>
b. God supplies
c. God satisfies
