I. FOCUS ON OUR GROWTH

Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness. But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever.

Amen. – 2 Peter 3:17–18

As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. – Colossians 2:6-7

II. FOCUS ON HIS GLORY

These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: – John 17:1

Glory = "to give weight to"

How to Glorify God

- 1. Praise Him with our lips. (Psalm 63:3, Luke 2:20)
- 2. Practice obedience. (1 Samuel 15:22, Revelations 22:14)
- 3. Pray in His name. (John 14:13)

- 4. Produce spiritual <u>truit</u>. (<u>John 15:8</u>)
- 5. Preserve <u>sexual</u> purity. (<u>1 Corinthians 6:18-20</u>)
- 6. Promote the good of others. (1 Corinthians 10:31)
- 7. Provide through generosity. (2 Corinthians 9:13)
- 8. Present yourself honorably among <u>unbelievers</u>. (1 Peter 2:12)
