MAKING OUR DAYS COUNT: Psalm 90

Sermon by Pastor Jeff Moss

What Psalm 90 is warning us against is this: don't become so obsessed with building worthless stuff that you bypass the things God put you here on earth to do.

Remember this: Satan doesn't always tempt with evil things, more often than not, he tempts you with neutral things that serve to distract us from the truly valuable things.

1. Life is futile in its [shortness](#) apart from God ([Psalm 90:3-6](#)).

As we grow older, the yesterdays are shorter each year. We look back and are shocked at how quickly "yesterday" passed.

2. Life is futile because of [sin](#) ([Psalm 90:7-11](#)).

"Wherefore by one man, sin entered into the world, and death by sin, and so death passed upon men for that all have sinned." [Romans 5:8](#)

"And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come." ([1Thessalonians 1:10](#))

"He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him." ([John 3:36](#))

3. Life has meaning when we live in the [eternal](#) . ([Psalm 90:1-2](#)).

4. God's blessing gives life [meaning](#) and [value](#) ([Psalm 90:12-17](#)).

- Live in light of [eternity](#) .
 - Labor for the [lasting](#) , not the passing.
 - Avoid wasted time that comes from [sinful](#) living.
