I. THE WORK ASSIGNED
Focus: Nehemiah 3
A. The laborers
In Nehemiah 3, there are 48 individual workers named in the chapter, and 42 different groups are mentioned.
In <u>1 Corinthians 12</u> and <u>14</u> , Paul compared individual Christians to members of the human body.
Every member is important.

The most important ability in the work of God is availability.
