Text. Ecclesiastes 10:1-20

Solomon – the author of books of **Ecclesiastes** and **Proverbs**

Proverbs 15:21 - "Folly is joy to him that is destitute of wisdom..."

I. THE LIFE OF A FOOL

Read Ecclesiastes 10:1

A. The description of their life

Saul - a perfection description of the life of a fool (see 1 Samuel 16:14)

B. The direction of their life

Read Eccl. 10:2

- The **right** hand = place of **honor** and **power**.
- The left hand = place of weakness and rejection

Our choices are made by us. The direction comes from the choices we make.

C. The display of their life

Read Eccl. 10:3

A fool's actions prove himself a fool.

II. THE LEADERSHIP OF A FOOL

"I haver never accepted what many people have kindly said – that linspired the nation. It was the nation and the race dwelling around the globe that had the lion heart. I had the luck to be called to give the roar." – Winston Churchill

Solomon warns about the leadership of a fool.

A. Indulgence

Read <u>Eccl. 10:16-17</u>

"Unlucky the land whose king is a young pup, and whose princes party all night. Lucky the land whose king is mature – where the princes behave themselves and don't drink themselves silly." (The Message, paraphrase)

B. Incompetence

Read Eccl. 10:18

"There is little correlation between a leader's effectiveness and his or her intelligence – imagination – or knowledge.

Brilliant people are strikingly ineffective. They never have learned that insights become effectiveness only through hard systematic work." Peter Drucker/leadership guru

C. Indifference

Read <u>Eccl. 10:19</u>

In what field are you a leader?

- * We will never stand alone before God.
- * We will stand with the **souls** of those we **lead**.

D. Indiscretion

Read Eccl. 10:20

Read <u>Proverbs 13:3</u>, <u>16:27-28</u>

Read <u>Eccl. 10:12</u>
