- Psalm 102:11 "My days are like a shadow that declineth"

## 2. Renew Your Thoughts

Ephesians 4:17-24

- Our mind is the **control center** of our actions
- We must saturate our minds with God's Word
- A fierce battle is waged against the mind

Read 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 – Paul speaks of the warfare concerning the thought life

- A. Satan's Desire (2 Corinthians 11:3, Genesis 6:5-7)
- B. Satan's Devices (2 Corinthians 4:4)

The Unguarded Doors that Satan will Enter

- 1. The perverse mind
- 2. The passive mind
- C. Satan's Defeat (2 Corinthians 10:3-5)

The Weapons To Use:

- 1. For the perverse mind there is repentance
- 2. For the passive mind there is resistance (James 4:7)
- 3. For the polluted mind there is renewal (Ephesians 4:23)
