Sermon Questions:

1. What event/gathering have you been a part of in which you have experienced the greatest amount of joy (a concert, championship game, etc.)? Describe the experience and what you felt.
2. Churches occasionally experience seasons of dreariness/the doldrums, for a variety of reasons. Can you give some examples? How can the Body of Christ wake itself up from these periods to be excited and joyful about its King and its mission?
3. What are some areas that the world needs to find peace, beyond just the end of geopolitical war? How does the gospel address them?
4. What are some areas that the Church needs to find peace?
5. What is meant by “because of the blood of my covenant with you” in Zech 9:11? What implications are there for the individual Christian’s walk and life?
6. Zech 9:16 says “God will save them.” How has salvation been experienced in your past, present, and will be experienced in your future?
7. Share your testimony (we should all have at least one, ready to go) of how God’s goodness and beauty has been revealed to you.
