Questions:

Reflection Question — What can we learn from the desperation of the woman and Jairus for Jesus to help them?

Application Question — Biblical faith always involves risk, because trust always involves risk. Where might God be calling you to take a ‘risk’ as you pursue knowing him more and spreading his Kingdom?
