Matthew 9:35-38 New Living Translation

³⁵ Jesus traveled through all the towns and villages of that area, teaching in the synagogues and announcing the Good News about the Kingdom. And He healed every kind of disease and illness. ³⁶ When He saw the crowds, He had compassion on them because they were confused and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. ³⁷ He said to His disciples, “The harvest is great, but the workers are few.” ³⁸ So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields.”

When we truly know Jesus, we cannot remain indifferent toward people who do not know Him or who have wandered far from Him.

➤ SALVATION

JESUS CAME TO SEEK AND SAVE THE LOST

Luke 15 New Living Translation

⁴ “If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them gets lost, what will he do? Won’t he leave the ninety-nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it? ⁵ And when he has found it, he will joyfully carry it home on his shoulders. ⁶ When he arrives, he will call together his friends and neighbors, saying, ‘Rejoice with me because I have found my lost sheep.’ ⁷ In the same way, there is more joy in heaven over one lost sinner who repents and returns to God than over ninety-nine others who are righteous and haven’t strayed away!

The fact that someone is far from God does not mean they are far from God's heart.

THE GOOD NEWS OF SALVATION

Salvation is not about people working their way back to God.

Luke 15:7

“In the same way, there is more joy in heaven over one lost sinner who repents and returns to God than over ninety-nine others who are righteous and haven't strayed away!”

One person.

One salvation.

One life changed.

One person coming home.

We may see a statistic. Jesus sees a name.

Jesus sees someone He loves.

DON'T BE LIKE THE OLDER BROTHER

Luke 15:25-32 New Living Translation

²⁵ “Meanwhile, the older son was in the fields working. When he returned home, he heard music and dancing in the house, ²⁶ and he asked one of the servants what was going on. ²⁷ ‘Your brother is back,’ he was told, ‘and your father has killed the fattened calf. We are celebrating because of his safe return.’

²⁸ “The older brother was angry and wouldn’t go in. His father came out and begged him, ²⁹ but he replied, ‘All these years I’ve slaved for you and never once refused to do a single thing you told me to. And in all that time you never gave me even one young goat for a feast with my friends. ³⁰ Yet when this son of yours comes back after squandering your money on prostitutes, you celebrate by killing the fattened calf!’

³¹ “His father said to him, ‘Look, dear son, you have always stayed by me, and everything I have is yours. ³² We had to celebrate this happy day. For your brother was dead and has come back to life! He was lost, but now he is found!’”

➤ A SPIRIT OF EVANGELISM

WHEN WE PRAY FOR THEM, WE CO-MISSION WITH GOD FOR THEM.

Matthew 9:36

“When He saw the crowds, He had compassion on them because they were confused and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.”

When we pray for those who do not know God or are far away from God, we align our prayers with God's heart.

JESUS TELLS US TO PRAY

Matthew 9:37–38

“The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask Him to send more workers into His fields.”

THE REMAINDER OF OUR 21 DAYS

WHO ARE YOU PRAYING FOR?

Don't just pray: "God, save the lost."

Pray specifically. Write down names.

Pray:

"Father, draw them to Jesus"

"Bind the spirit that blinds their minds"

"Bring them to a personal relationship with You, Father"

"Place compassionate believers in their paths"

"Release the spirit of wisdom, and revelation on them so they may know You"

When we pray for people who are far from God, we are not just asking God to change them. We are allowing God to change our hearts toward them.

WHAT IF GOD ANSWERED OUR PRAYERS?

Revival begins when God's people are committed to care about what God cares about. God cares about people.
